In addition, we will ship contacts and glasses to your home for no charge. We understand that some of you may feel at risk of having to over wear your contacts. Be assured that our team can ship contacts directly to you. If you are experiencing a problem with your eyewear, we can help you acquire a backup pair, replace or provide you with new. Simply call our office.
- Please do not bring extra people with you to our office. We are keeping our waiting room seating to a minimum.
- We are offering curbside pickup for glasses and contacts. Please do not come into the office to pick up these items. When you arrive, phone the office 317-887-2800 and one of our staff will bring your items to you.
- If you have an after-hours eye emergency, PLEASE call our office first BEFORE going to an emergency room. Follow the phone prompts for the on-call optometrist. Emergency eye symptoms would include flashes of light, floaters in vision, eye pain or sudden loss of vision.
